We celebrate the dedication of the Mother church of Latin Catholicism, the Lateran Basilica in Rome. According to an inscription at the entrance of the building, it ranks as the "Mother and Head of All Churches in the (Holy) City and throughout the World" - OMNIUM URBIS ET ORBIS ECCLESIAE MATER ET CAPUT. This church, not St Peter's, is the Pope's Cathedral. Also called the Church of Holy Saviour or the Church of St John Baptist, it was the baptism church of ancient Rome.
